A letter from Bruce Reyes-Chow, Linda Valentine, and Gradye Parsons on the current financial crisis was shared. Additional information on resources that related to the credit crisis was also shared.

The annual report of the Stated Clerk was received. The number of elders and ministers attending the meetings of the year was reported as was the racial ethnic elder breakdown for 2007. The Clerk recommended that the Presbytery of Florida authorize an additional elder commissioner from Bethel, First Korean, Ft. Walton, Pensacola Korean, Pleasant Grove and Trinity United Presbyterian Church. This was approved. The clerk moved that the Presbytery of Florida encourage Majority Racial Ethnic Congregations/Sessions which have minority racial ethnic congregants who are elders to send them as elder commissioners to Presbytery of Florida meetings.
